1. FIGHTING CHILD POVERTY IN GERMANY BY INCREASING FAMILY ALLOWANCE AS WELL AS FREE LUNCH AND TICKETS FOR TRANSPORTATION TO SCHOOL AS PART OF THE EDUCATION AND PARTICIPATION PACKAGE
2. SEVERAL INITIATIVES SUCH AS THE "COMPACT WITH AFRICA", "PRO!AFRICA" OR "CREATING PERSPECTIVES!" ARE INTENDED TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF COUNTRIES IN THE GLOBAL SOUTH, E.G. IN EGYPT, ETHIOPIA OR GHANA

1. FEDERAL GOVERNMENT INITIATIVE "EINWELT OHNE HUNGER": INVESTMENT OF AROUND 2 BILLION EUROS ANNUALLY IN EMERGING AND DEVELOPING COUNTRIES TO HELP PEOPLE ON SITE PRODUCE ENOUGH FOOD
2. MOBILIZATION OF ADDITIONAL ONE BILLION EUROS IN 2022 TO COMBAT THE FOOD CRISIS, OF WHICH THE FEDERAL FOREIGN OFFICE WILL USE ALMOST HALF TO INCREASE ITS HUMANITARIAN AID AND THUS SUPPLY BASIC FOODSTUFFS TO MILLIONS OF PEOPLE IN NEED

1. GERMANY IS A FOUNDING MEMBER OF THE CEPI VACCINE INITIATIVE: FUNDING OF A TOTAL OF 230 MILLION EUROS SINCE 2017

1. HIGHER EDUCATION PACT: CREATION OF MORE THAN ONE MILLION ADDITIONAL STUDY OPPORTUNITIES AT GERMAN UNIVERSITIES SO FAR
2. SUPPORT OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROJECTS IN MORE THAN 60 COUNTRIES LIKE ETHIOPIA, AFGHANISTAN, YEMEN, AND TOGO BY FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SCHOOLS, TRAINING CENTERS AND TRAINING OF TEACHERS

5. GENDER EQUALITY

1. 30 PERCENT QUOTA FOR WOMEN ON SUPERVISORY BOARDS IN GERMANY SINCE 2016, WHICH HAS LED TO A SIGNIFICANT INCREASE IN THE PROPORTION OF WOMEN IN THESE BOARDS
2. GERMANY ACTS AS VICE-CHAIR TO THE 66TH AND 67TH COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN (CSW) OF THE UNITED NATIONS' ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL AS PRINCIPAL GLOBAL INTERGOVERNMENTAL BODY EXCLUSIVELY DEDICATED TO PROMOTION OF GENDER EQUALITY AND EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN

6. CLEAN WATER AND SANITATION

1. IN DEVELOPMENT COOPERATION, GERMANY IS THE WORLD'S SECOND-LARGEST DONOR IN THE WATER SECTOR
2. ACCORDING TO THE GERMAN SUSTAINABILITY STRATEGY, AN ADDITIONAL 10 MILLION PEOPLE SHOULD HAVE ACCESS TO DRINKING WATER EACH YEAR BY 2030 THROUGH GERMAN ASSISTANCE

7. AFFORDABLE AND CLEAN ENERGY

1. IN GERMANY, AROUND 42.9 PERCENT OF ELECTRICITY COMES FROM RENEWABLE SOURCES AND THE COMMITMENT IS TO REACH 65 PERCENT BY 2030
2. SUPPORT OF THE ENERGIZING DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM WITH THE GOAL THAT AT LEAST AN ADDITIONAL 26.6 MILLION PEOPLE WORLDWIDE GAIN ACCESS TO DEMAND-DRIVEN, CLIMATE-FRIENDLY ENERGY BY THE END OF 2025

8. *DECENT WORK & ECONOMIC GROWTH*

1. AS SET OUT IN THE NATIONAL ACTION PLAN ON BUSINESS AND HUMAN RIGHTS, THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT REQUIRES ALL COMPANIES TO COMPLY WITH THEIR HUMAN RIGHTS DUE DILIGENCE OBLIGATIONS IN GERMANY AND WORLDWIDE
2. GERMANY SUPPORTS INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS THE INTERNATIONAL LABOR ORGANIZATION AND ITS ALLIANCE TO ABOLISH CHILD AND FORCED LABOR, AS WELL AS THE VISION ZERO FUND TO STRENGTHEN OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY

9. *INDUSTRY, INNOVATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE*

1. GERMANY LEADS THE FIELD IN PATENT APPLICATIONS AND RESEARCH AND RANKS SEVENTH IN COMPETITIVENESS
2. INCREASE PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SPENDING ON RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT TO AT LEAST 3.5 PERCENT OF GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT ANNUALLY BY 2025

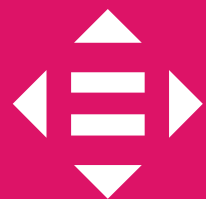

2. SPECIAL INITIATIVE "FIGHTING THE CAUSES OF FLIGHT - REINTEGRATING REFUGEE" AIMS TO HELP REDUCE INEQUALITIES TO PREVENT CONFLICTS WHICH FORCE PEOPLE TO FLEE

2. CONTRIBUTION OF 1.5 BILLION EUROS TO THE GREEN CLIMATE FUND

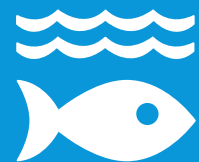
